 - 1. This office through the Curriculum Implementation Division adheres to the observance of the Character First Program of our City Government. Hence, all are enjoined for the implementation of the monthly character traits in our respective offices and all schools in the division.
 - 2 The list of character traits for this year are the same as last year's monthly character traits (see Enclosure 1). This was decided by the Character City Council during the meeting conducted last December 29, 2020 via zoom.
 - The Character First Program is in line with our division PROJECT 3. FUNCTIONAL APPROACH TO CHARACTER EDUCATION (FACE), suggested activities are the following:
 - a. hang every month, from January to December, a 2x3 ft. tarpaulin of the character trait in any conspicuous place
 - b. integration of the monthly character trait in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao and across learning areas
 - c. discussion of the character trait of the month during Monday convocation/Flag rites
 - d. giving of recognition/awards to students, teachers and non-teaching staff exemplifying the character trait of the month
 - Public Schools District Supervisors and Education Program Supervisor in 4. Values Ed. shall monitor and evaluate the implementation of the program in all schools. Submit monthly accomplishment report in soft copy through this email address emma.javier@deped.gov.ph


