## 17th NATIONAL CELEBRATION OF DENTAL HEALTH MONTH

- The Philippine Dental Health Month is observed in February. This annual observance started in 1951 as National Dental Health Week but in February 24, 2004, it was expanded into a month-long celebration, pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 559 signed by then President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo.
- 2. The observance of the activity aims to:
  - a. strengthen public awareness on the importance of the good oral health.
  - b. it encourages dentists, students, relevant government agencies, and professional organizations to reach out to more people with no access to dental services, especially those who are in countryside.
  - c. promote month long awareness campaign aims to work with learners, caregivers, teachers and other professionals to raise awareness of the benefits of good oral health care.
  - 3. The Office through the Health and Nutrition Section will lead the celebration of the 17th National Dental Health Month 2021 with the theme "Ngipin ay alagaan mula sa sinapupunan para sa magandang ngiti hanggang katandaan".

## 5. Criteria for the Bright Smile Contest are the following:

a. The contest aims to promote self-esteem and oral health awareness among learners from Grades 4 to 12.

b. The contest is open to all Grades 4-12 learners from public elementary and secondary schools in the Division of Tuguegarao City.

 Each elementary school should choose one (1) representative coming either from Grade 4-6 while;

d. Each secondary school should choose only one (1) representative for Junior High School category and one (1) representative from Senior High School category.

e. Each representative should prepare a minimum of three-minute videopresentation of proper tooth brushing and email it to jennifer.tuliao@deped.gov.ph or hns04sgod@gmail.com with filename BSC-NAME-SCHOOL (Example: BSC-Maria De la Cruz-Cataggaman Elementary School). The video should showcase the bright smile and the oral structures of the learner.


f. One winner for Grade 4-6 category, junior high school category and senior high school category will be selected from the submitted entries of the schools.

g. Prizes will be given in a form of health or dental kits and a certificate of recognition.

h. Deadline of submission will be on February 22, 2021 at 5:00 PM. School entries submitted beyond the set date and time will not be honored.

 Announcement of winners will be on February 29, 2021 through a duly signed division memorandum.

Division health and nutrition section personnel, school health coordinators and WinS coordinators shall take the lead in the celebration.
