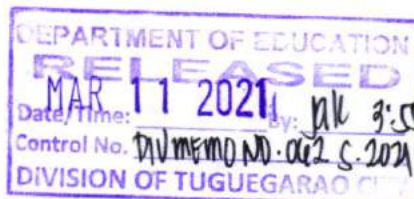

MATHSpoken Poetry

Theme: *Electronic Showcasing of Impressive Performances on Numerical Abilities for the Youngsters Attuned in the New Normal*

1. The competition is open to all elementary, junior high school and senior high students of the Division of Tuguegarao City.
2. There should only be one (1) pair- participant (learner and parent) tandem from the elementary and junior high school and for the senior high school one learner is allowed to participate.
3. The contestants must use terms or concepts in Mathematics in crafting his/her spoken word poetry.
4. The MATHSpoken poetry can be in English, Tagalog or combination for the Elementary while in the Secondary levels it must be purely ENGLISH.
5. Participants are required to create a 3 to 5-minute video reciting their own MATHSpoken poetry.
6. Schools should upload their video entry 3 days before the contest thru the provided link.
7. All compositions of the participants must be submitted to the aforementioned link and labeled as ELEM/JHS/SHS-Name of School-MATHSpoken.
Ex. (JHS-CNHS-MATHSpoken)
8. The criteria for judging are as follows:
Relevance to the Theme 30%
Delivery 30%
Word Choice 20%
Originality 20%
TOTAL 100%
9. The top three winners will be recognized at the end of the program.



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ONLINE MATH QUIZ BEE

GUIDELINES:

1. The QUIZ BEE is open to 6th, 10th and 12th Grades learners of the Division of Tuguegarao City.
2. There should be 1 participant each from 6th, 10th and 12th Grades.
3. Only the registered official contestants are allowed to join and must SIGN IN on the platform. Coaches, parents and others can view the quiz on Facebook live or YouTube live only.
4. Participants should be familiar in the use of the Google forms, Microsoft forms, and/or Quizizz platforms. A dry-run shall be conducted **before** the scheduled contests.
5. All participants must use a computer laptop or desktop only. Use of smartphones is **discouraged** since a bigger window is needed for you to comfortably key in your answers depending on the platform that the learner will be using.
6. A strong internet connection should be used to eliminate lags and disconnection during the competition.
7. Participants who will experience technical difficulties such as internet disconnection and power interruption are still allowed to answer the succeeding questions. However, missed questions will **no longer** be repeated for them.
8. The activity will use the Google Spreadsheet in registering participants. The Google Link for registration for this contest shall be forwarded to the schools five (5) days before the conduct of the activity. (Please get in touch with the technical working group for the said activity).
9. The activity will use the Google Meet on the day of the event. The links will be sent to the e-mail addresses (please use Gmail accounts) of the participants one (1) day before the event.
10. On the day of the event, the meeting room will be opened at 8:00 AM. All participants should be able to LOG IN one (1) hour before the start of the activity. The activity will officially start at 9:00 A.M.

11. Each grade level shall have a facilitator who shall monitor the conduct of the said event.

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12. Late participants will no longer be admitted once the program has started.
13. Certificates of Recognition will be given to the winners. Certificates of Participation will be given to all participants.
14. All participants are required to accomplish an electronic feedback form right after the conduct of the activity

MECHANICS:

1. Video cameras of all participants should be enabled during the entire conduct of the event. Coaches or parents should keep their distance from the contestants. Only contestants should be seen on the camera. No camera would also mean disqualification for the participants. Coaches or parents visible on the background will automatically disqualify the contestant. Background change setting IS NOT ALLOWED for the contestants.
2. All questions will be content based on the MELCs issued by the Department of Education.
3. All participants will be given the link to access the questionnaire and its corresponding electronic answer sheet.
4. There shall be twenty (20) questions consisting of: ten (10) fifteen-second questions worth 2 points each of the FIRST ROUND, five (5) thirty-second questions worth 3 points each for the SECOND ROUND and five (5) one-minute questions worth 5 points each for the THIRD ROUND, for a total of sixty (60) points. The timing in each round begins when the Quizmaster gives the go-signal after the second reading of the question.
 - 4.1 The 15-second questions are to be solved mentally.
 - 4.2 For the 30-second questions, contestants shall have a clean sheet of paper where they can write their solutions. They may begin solving as soon as the Quizmaster begins reading the question.
 - 4.3 For the 1-minute questions, contestants shall have a clean sheet of paper where they can write their solutions. They may begin solving as soon as the Quizmaster begins reading the question.
5. In case of a tie, the Quizmaster shall read a sudden death question.
6. All questions will be read by the quizmaster twice. Participants are given specific time only to answer the questions. Changing of answers from the previous questions are not allowed. The system will give a notification to the facilitator if changes were done. Any changed answer will not be counted as part of the score.
7. Participants will ONLY key in in their answer AFTER the Quizmaster has read the question for the SECOND time.
8. Participants shall not modify their electronic answer sheets. They are not also allowed to share same with other participants.

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9. The difficult round will commence after the average round with another form link to be given to the participants, which will only be forwarded during the quiz bee proper on the zoom or google meet chat box.
10. The quizmaster will announce if the contestants could open the link for the difficult round.
11. The participants will be given the link for the difficult round with 5 questions at the same time. The contestants will only key in their answer for every question after the quiz master will give them the go signal within the specific time.
12. After the difficult round, the scores will be automatically tallied by the system.
14. Announcement of scores will be AFTER the difficult round.



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Guidelines for the Demonstration Teaching Showdown (Teacher Category)

1. The contest is open to all elementary and secondary Mathematics teachers.
2. There will be 3 level of contest for the teachers to compete namely:
 - a. School level
 - b. District level
 - c. Division level
3. The Division level contest understood that the winners from the District level are the ones who will compete in the Grand Finals.
4. Teacher- participant is only allotted 50 minutes to conduct his/her online demonstration teaching.
5. This will be done in an online synchronous manner.
6. The criteria for judging will be based on the Classroom Observation for Teachers (COT)
7. There will be one winner in the Elementary, Junior High School and Senior High School)
8. Submission of the District winners will be submitted March 31,2020 by the District Heads.
