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

- 6. Incase of tie, the quizmaster shall read a sudden death question.
- 7. The final results, especially the top three winners shall be presented by the technical team and to be read by the quizmaster. Once results are read and winners are presented by the quizmaster, these shall be final and irrevocable.





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Poster and Slogan Contests
