REGISTRATION OF TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING PERSONNEL WITH COMORBIDITIES IN THE COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAM

To:

Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief, School Governance and Operations Division Health and Nutrition Section Personnel Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. This Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division Health and Nutrition Section strongly supports the implementation of the CoViD-19 Vaccination Program headed by the Department of Health. In this connection, the Office through the Health and Nutrition Section in partnership with the City Health Office encourages all teaching and non-teaching personnel with comorbidities of the Division to coordinate and communicate with their respective barangay health workers for registration in the vaccination program. The schedule of vaccination will be determined by your respective barangays.
- 2. The roll-out of vaccination for priority groups A3-A5 is ongoing in areas classified as High Risk in CoVid-19 such as Tuguegarao City, Cagayan. All non-teaching and teaching personnel with comorbidities in the Division are qualified to register in the vaccination program under A3 priority groups. The following are lists of co-morbidities:
 - a. Chronic Respiratory diseases
 - b. Hypertension
 - c. Cardiovascular diseases
 - d. Chronic kidney disease
 - e. Cerebrovascular Accident (Stroke)
 - f. Malignancy
 - g. Diabetes Mellitus
 - h. Obesity
 - i. Neurologic disease
 - i. Chronic liver disease
 - k. Tuberculosis
 - 1. Chronic Respiratory Tract Infections
 - m. Immunodeficiency diseases (Lupus)
 - n. Others

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- 3. Personnel are advised to prepare any of the following documents before their scheduled vaccination as proof of co-morbidity:
 - a. Medical Certificate issued by your Attending Physician within the past 18 months
 - b. Doctor's prescription to medicines for the past six months
 - c. Hospital records such as discharge summary and medical abstract
 - d. Surgical records and pathology reports


