DAYAW NA IBANAG ANNA ITAWES FESTIVAL



- 1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 1906, s. 2009, declaring October of every year as the National Indigenous Peoples Month and the Department of Education recognizing the presidential proclamation through its issuance of DepEd Order No. 148, s. 2016 Observance of the National Indigenous Peoples with the theme "Karunungan ng mga Katutubong Pamayanan: Limang Daang Taong Pagtatanggol at Pagpapayabong, Ipagpatuloy sa Pangalawang Dekada ng Katutubong Edukasyon", the Division of Tuguegarao City will hold a virtual culminating activity titled "Dayaw na Ibanag anna Itawes Festival 2.0" on December 09, 2021.
- 2. Given the forthcoming celebration, the four (4) districts namely: North District, East District, West District, and Northeast District shall choose their participants from their respective schools to represent their district/s in the different contested categories. The announcement of winners will be on **December 09**, 2021, to culminate the IP month celebration. The top three scorers in all contested categories shall be declared as winners. Cash prizes await the winners.
- 3. The different contested categories shall be video recorded and submitted on a thru this google drive https://bit.ly/2ZCtgWg on or before December 01, 2021, for the judges to review. The link to the drive will be sent before the said submission of entries.

- 1. The contest is open to Elementary Ibanag and Itawes learners. The contested piece entitled Pammakakua (Ibanag and Itawes versions) shall be sent to the schools through the IPEd Focal Persons.
- 2. The piece shall be delivered either in Ibanag or Itawes.
- 3. Each district will have one (1) contestant to the division level competition.
- 4. The contestants are required to follow minimum health protocols like social distancing, wearing of mask and face shield
- 5. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Expression	-10 %
b. Enunciation	-20 %
c. Phrasing and Juncture	-20 %
d. Fluency	-20 %
e. Accuracy	-20 %
f. Poise and Composure	-10 %

6. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

II. IMPROMPTU SPEAKING/PAPPALAPPA


- 1. The contest is open to Secondary Ibanag and Itawes learners.
- 2. The impromptu speaking shall revolve around the theme.
- 3. The piece shall be delivered either in Ibanag or Itawes.
- 4. Each district will have one (1) contestant to the division level competition.
- 5. The contestants are required to follow minimum health protocols like social distancing, wearing of mask and face shield
- 6. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Expression	-10 %
b. Enunciation	-20 %
c. Message	-20 %
d. Fluency	-20 %
e. Accuracy	-20 %
f. Poise and Composure	-10 %

- 4. The contestants are required to follow minimum health protocols like social distancing, wearing of mask and face shield
- 5. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Voice Quality	-	30 %
b. Pronunciation	-	15 %
c. Timing	-	15 %
d. Stage Presence	-	15 %
e. Mastery of Lyrics	-	15 %
f. Audience Impact	2	10 %

6. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.


IV. VOCAL DUET

- 3. Each district will have two (2) contestants (1 Elementary, 1 Secondary) to the division level competition.
- 4. The contestants are required to follow minimum health protocols like social distancing, wearing of mask and face shield
- 5. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Voice Quality	-	30 %
b. Pronunciation	-	15 %
c. Timing	_	15 %
d. Stage Presence	-	15 %
e. Mastery of Lyrics	-	15 %
f Audience Impact	-	10 %

- 4. Each district will only have one (1) entry to the division level competition.
- 5. The contestants are required to follow minimum health protocols like social distancing, wearing of mask and face shield
- 6. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Choreography (Creativity, Artistry, Style & Originality)	-30 %
b. Execution (Timing, Coordination, Projection & Expression)	-30 %
c. Costume	-20 %
d. Audience Impact	-20 %

7. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.


VI. MASCOTA DANCE

- 1. The contest is open to all Ibanag and Itawes elementary and secondary school teachers.
- 2. Each participating group shall form one pair.
- 3. Each district will only have one (1) entry to the division level competition.
- 4. The official dance piece shall be provided by the participating groups.
- 5. The contestants are required to follow minimum health protocols like social distancing, wearing of mask and face shield
- 6. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Choreography (Creativity, Artistry, Style & Originality)	-30 %
b. Execution (Timing, Coordination, Projection & Expression)	-30 %
c. Costume	-20 %
d. Audience Impact	-20 %

7. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

- 2. The topic of the verso shall revolve around festival occasion.
- 3. There shall two (2) representatives (1 Elementary and 1 Secondary) per district.
- 4. The delivery of verso shall not exceed to five minutes.
- 5. The contestants are required to follow minimum health protocols like social distancing, wearing of mask and face shield
- 6. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Fluency	-30 %
b. Expression	-20 %
c. Enunciation	-20 %
d. Content and Depth	-20 %
e. Audience Impact	-10 %

7. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.


VIII. TIKTOK

- 2. The topic of the tiktok shall revolve around festival occasion.
- 3. There shall only be one (1) entry per district.
- 4. The tiktok shall not exceed to three (3) minutes.
- 5. A minimum of five (5) and a maximum of eight (8) participants only.
- 6. The contestants are required to follow minimum health protocols like social distancing, wearing of mask and face shield.
- 7. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Relevance to the theme	-40 %
b. Choreography	-30 %
c. Creativity	-15 %
d. Entertainment factor	-15 %






