1. The Office through the School Governance Operations Division- Health and Nutrition Section gladly reports the successful implementation of the feeding program that has been conducted from November 18, 2021 to January 21,2022 in all public elem. schools amidst the challenges brought about by the pandemic.
2. There were 10 varieties of Nutritious Food Products delivered in the 28 schools for 60 feeding days and 33 days for fresh milk feeding. A total of 3288 recipients from Grade 1, severely wasted and wasted school children were benefitted from this program.

4. The following school feeding coordinators are highly recognized for their unparallel commitment in support to the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program SY 2021-2022:



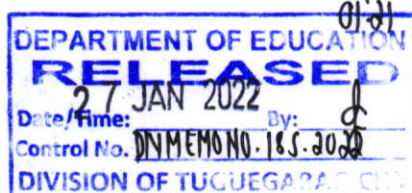
