# ORIENTATION OF PRIVATE SCHOOLS ON THE PREPARATION FOR THE LIMITED FACE-TO-FACE, EXPANSION AND TRANSITIONING TO NEW NORMAL LEARNING MODALITY

1. With the aim of improving the learning outcomes amidst the challenges of COVID19, the Department of Education issued the Department of Education Memorandum No. 071 s, 2021 entitled Preparation for the Pilot Face-to-face, Expansion and Transitioning to New Normal, an Order providing guidance on the mechanisms and standards for the safe resumption of face-to-face classes.
2. The CT already commenced the implementation of this Order in all public schools and were ordered to conduct a self-assessment and evaluation using the School Readiness Assessment Tool to pre-determine the necessary logistical needs, as a requirement to participate in the limited face-to-face expansion and part of New Normal School Operations (please see the attached tool).
5. With this, a Virtual Orientation is prepared for all Private Schools to be held on February 15, 2022 at exactly 8:00 A.M for the CT to discuss the prescribed areas of concern in the following topics:
